Define the PDF/X-4 settings

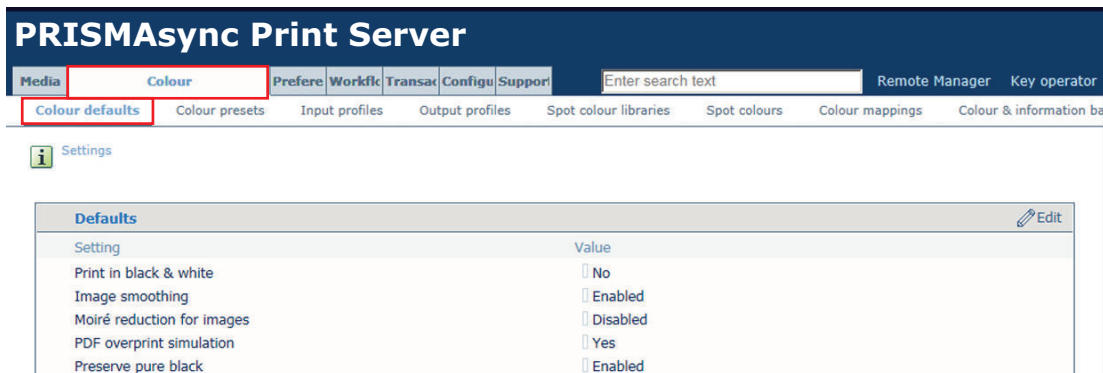
Use the Settings Editor to define the PDF/X-4 settings on the PRISMAsync Print Server. Note that Settings Editor screenshots in this document can slightly differ from your situation because the availability of settings depend on the print system you use.

Before you begin

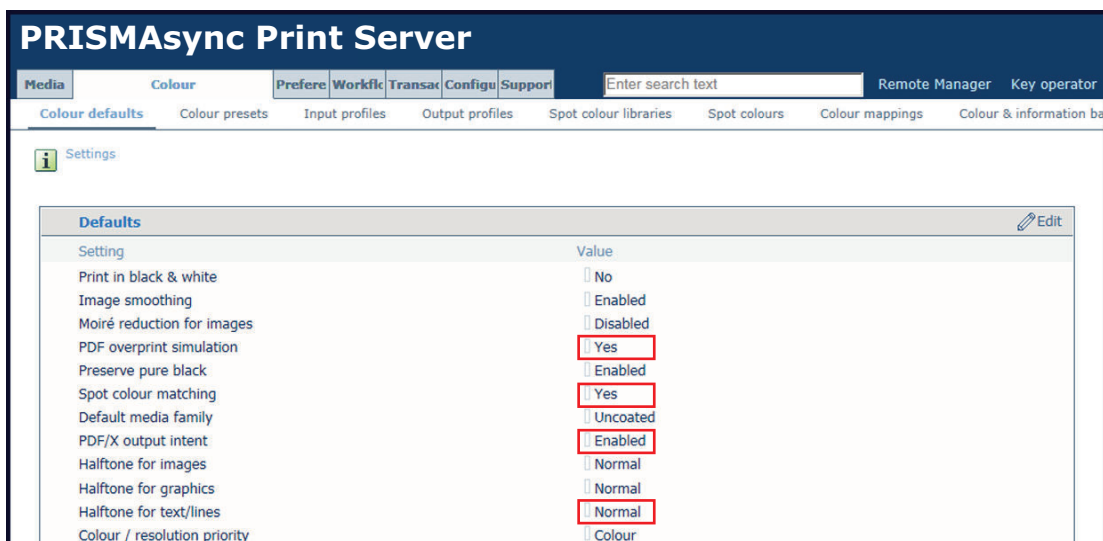
You must have the rights to define the PDF/X-4 settings. Refer to the user manual of the print system for detailed information.

Procedure

1. Enter the IP-address or the hostname of the PRISMAsync Print Server in the address bar of your web browser.
2. Go to [Colour] -> [Colour defaults].



3. Make sure that the following settings are enabled. If required, change these settings:
 - [PDF overprint simulation]
 - [Spot colour matching]
 - [PDF/X output intent]
 - [Halftone for text/lines]



Check the PDF/X-4 compliance

You can check if the print system complies to the PDF/X-4 standard with 'Ghent PDF Output Suite 5.0' that is offered free of charge.

Procedure

1. Go to <http://www.gwg.org/workflow-tools/test-suites/ghent-output-suite/>
2. Download and read the main documentation.
3. Download all patches and detailed documentation.
4. Print the file 'Ghent_PDF-Output-Test-V50_ALL_X4.pdf'.
5. Take the printed output to check the PDF/X-4 compliance.
