Fiery FS100 Pro through and including FS350 Pro servers support PDF/X-4 therefore guaranteeing that print providers process jobs with the graphic designer's true intent for content created with tools such as Adobe® Creative Cloud®. Follow the instructions below for successful output.


Ghent PDF Output Suite 5.0 update

Fiery color settings:



Launch Fiery Command WorkStation®. Select the job and click on Properties.

1. Click the **Color tab** from within Job Properties and enable Adobe PDF Print Engine Preferred.




2. In the **Color Input** section select the checkboxes for:

- Use RGB embedded profiles
- Use CMYK embedded profiles
- Use Gray embedded profiles



3. In the **Color settings** section, select the checkboxes for:

- PDF/X output intent
- Separate RGB/Lab to CMYK source
- Composite overprint (default setting)
- Optimize RGB transparency
